Every journey is marked by milestones - indicators of progress, significant occurrences, and



points of interest. In the journey of Assemblies of God Missions activity in Africa, the emergence of what is called tabernacle technology is already viewed as one of those milestones.

No precise date marks the creation of tabernacle technology. It just emerged through the creative ministry gifts of missionaries ambitious to meet church growth needs while stretching available resources to the maximum possible.

Africa Tabernacle Evangelism was formed in the early 90s with the mission of exploiting tabernacle technology across the continent. In the intervening years, a powerful team of missionaries, visiting teams, and local believers have applied tabernacle technology in a variety of ways for a variety of purposes; mostly local churches, occasionally missionary housing, also school campuses, etc.

Tabernacle technology responds to a local need with a free-standing steel structure supporting a tin roof. Local believers can then embellish the structure with walls, windows, doors, facades, etc. as they wish. For a relatively small investment, a basic church structure can be erected and put to use.

Tabernacle technology offers a totally flexible form of church construction for current needs and future growth.

The components are simple; concrete footings, steel trusses, corrugated roofing, a few screws, and an ample dose of elbow grease.

Depending on site preparation and concrete footings being in place, a tabernacle structure can usually be erected in less than a week.

Although there is no rule about size, normal local church tabernacles measure approximately 1,700 square feet. When needed, several tabernacles can be combined to create a larger facility seating thousands - using the same technology.



Across Africa, tabernacle technology is being used for local assemblies, schools, housing, children's ministries facilities, etc. There is really no limit to size, design, and use.

The Assemblies of God in Africa has grown from approximately 2 million believers and 12,000 local assemblies in 1989 to almost 10 million believers and 34,000 local assemblies today. **For such a level of church growth, cutting edge thinking, strategy and methods are needed.** The Spirit of God enables men to discern (understand, know) the times...to be cutting edge. Africa Tabernacle Evangelism certainly fits the mold!
